2. What time period was the play written in?
3. What are the major themes explored in the play?
4. Are there any specific historical events or cultural contexts that influenced the play?
5. What are the characteristics of the characters in the play? Are they realistic, symbolic, or stylized?
6. How does the play portray the setting or environment?
7. Does the play adhere to a linear narrative structure or does it experiment with non-linear storytelling?
8. What are the dominant emotions or moods conveyed in the play?
9. Does the play rely on poetic or everyday language in its dialogue?
10. Are there any specific theatrical techniques or devices used in the play, such as symbolism, metaphors, or physicality?

By researching and answering these questions, you will gain insights into the various aspects of the play that will help them identify the theatrical movement or genre it aligns with.
