All students in Musical Theater 1 will be playing ensemble roles in our show this year. Rehearsals will take place mostly in class, however some cast members might be called to attend a rehearsal on a Friday afternoon. Those dates will be posted after the show is cast, so please be honest with your conflicts when you fill out the audition form online!

Starting in January, we will have rehearsals for the entire cast on various days after school.

Auditions:

Auditions will be held during class September 10th and 11th. All students will be asked to sing the audition song listed below. You will either be asked to sing it as a solo, or with a small group. You should be MEMORIZED.

After everyone sings, everyone will learn some harmony from the show. They will then sing that harmony in small groups. There may also be some improvisation or acting done at these auditions.

You can find the sheet music on our website by under “Audition Music” and the tracks to practice with under “Guide Vocals” and then “Performance Vocals”. For the actual audition you will sing with along with the tracks without the words. Those tracks will be provided at the auditions.

Once the show is cast there may be some additional lines and/or featured roles within the ensemble to be distributed.

If you are a dancer and are interested in a featured dance part from the ensemble, please prepare your own choreography for song #5 “Big Blue World Part 2”. Please use the music from 2 min 10 seconds to 2 minutes and 40 seconds. You will dance to your choreography for the auditions for this 30 second cut.
