

Cast Size: 8- 10 players.

Eurydice : *female* (15-17) A curious, intelligent young woman who finds herself on an unexpected journey that challenges her understanding of love, family, and memory.

Orpheus – *male* (16-19) A boy who loves 2 things- music and Eurydice, and will go to any lengths to win them over in his heart.

Father – *male* (45-52) Eurydice's loving and gentle father, whose wisdom, warmth, and devotion shape much of her journey.

A Nasty Interesting Man - (*Any Gender and Age*) A mysterious and unpredictable figure who brings both humor and unease to the world.

Lord of the Underworld – (*Any Gender and Age*) A mysterious and unpredictable figure who runs the Underworld.

The Stones - (*Any Gender and Age*) A number of unique characters who represent the rules and order of the Underworld. They can be funny, stern, and surprisingly insightful.

- **Big Stone** – Confident, authoritative, and the self-appointed leader.
- **Loud Stone** – Bold, energetic, and never afraid to speak up.
- **Little Stone** – Observant, thoughtful, and quietly perceptive.
- There may be more stones cast for a larger ensemble.

Synopsis:

Eurydice by Sarah Ruhl is a modern retelling of the classic Greek myth, told from Eurydice's point of view. Blending humor, heart, and imagination, the play explores love, loss, memory, and the bonds that connect us to the people we care about. Set in a dreamlike world where the ordinary and the extraordinary collide, *Eurydice* invites audiences to consider what it means to remember, to let go, and to find hope in unexpected places.
